

NAFTA "LOW VALUE" ORIGIN STATEMENT

Where goods are valued at less than \$1600.00 Canadian, the formal **Certificate of Origin** is not required. Instead, the exporter or producer may provide a statement in the form outlined below.

This "Low Value" statement may be handwritten, stamped, or typed on the actual invoice for which preferential **NAFTA** rates are being claimed.

In order to be valid, the wording of this statement must be identical to that shown below, complete with signature, date and exporter/producer indication.
